Sunday Learning

At WHBC, each child has a special Sunday school opportunity.

“Rock-a-bye”

Children will begin their journey of faith from birth to 36 months with the Rock-a-bye curriculum. Rock-a-bye helps them develop a foundation of faith. Loving teachers guide them to understand that God loves them.

“Rock Solid”

Children ages 3 through 6th grade seek to build a heart of faith through the Rock Solid curriculum. Rock Solid has been constructed from the bottom up to provide a fun and biblically sound curriculum. Each class will experience age-appropriate lessons, activities, crafts, stories, and games. The total experience provides them with a better understanding of God.



Sunday Worship



At the 10:50 AM worship service, the entire congregation gathers for worship with exception of infants. After the special children’s message, ages three and up are led by shepherds to their worship area. At their special worship service in the chapel, they have a time of worship through lessons and music. The upbeat music gets the children on their feet. After the initial gathering, children age 3 through pre-K will be escorted to a classroom for story time. Children kindergarten and up will remain in the chapel for a hands-on experience learning about God’s word. This program is intended to progress them into the adult worship service.

Wednesday Service

West Hills Baptist offers a complete line-up of children’s activities on Wednesday evenings. Beginning at 6 PM, the groups meet for Bible Time or Missions. Following the first session are grade level choir rehearsals. Nursery services are available on Wednesday evenings.

Ages 3 - Kindergarten

The children will cover Bible stories from both the Old and the New Testaments. Each week will include a Bible story, Bible verse, and a craft activity to reinforce the lesson.

1st - 3rd Grades - “Learning to Use My Bible”

This study uses a step-by-step approach and will open the Bible message to the children for their lifelong faith journey.

4th - 6th Grades - “SPARK”

These sessions focus on missions within the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. The “SPARK” curriculum is used and supplemented with local mission activities.
